The South Street Seaport Museum tells the unique story of how modern New York started in the historic 19th Century Seaport— a place where goods, labor, and cultures were exchanged through work, trade and commerce.



Walk the cobble stoned streets from the historic galleries and Museum shops to the wood-planked pier where our ships are docked.

- Discover the Museum’s Schermerhorn Row buildings considered the city’s “first world trade center”
- Climb aboard the 1885 tall ship *Wavertree*, where ships just like her would have lined the piers from the Battery to the Brooklyn Bridge
- Visit Bowne & Co., New York’s oldest operating business under the same name, and see letterpress printing on the Museum’s 19th Century presses



GETTING HERE

Find us: Walking distance from the NY Ferry Pier 11, most major subway lines and Circle Line and Water Taxi both stop at the Museum’s Pier 16. **In The Area:** Surrounded by food and shopping options, we are a short distance from the 9/11 Memorial, Battery Park, The Brooklyn Bridge & Wall Street,

BUS DROP-OFF: For coach tours, drop-off areas are available. Although we do not have on-site motor coach parking, we can recommend some options based on your schedule and timing in the area.

SAMPLE EXPERIENCES:

Seaport Business: Tour Wavertree and the warehouse buildings of Schermerhorn Row and then learn how the printing industry kept businesses flowing. In a hands-on workshop, using 19th century technology, your group will get a chance to operate a historic press and take home what they print.

Crew and Cargo: Tour the museum building exhibitions and visit the print shop. Then participate in an in-depth visit to 1885 cargo ship Wavertree and experience the world of transatlantic sailors through hands-on activities

Stories through Architecture: Tour Wavertree and the historic buildings of Schermerhorn Row, and learn how they changed over time. Then take a walk through the Seaport District to see the history told by the exteriors of other neighborhood buildings







Notes: Because of the historic nature of our ships and buildings, access to most spaces will require navigating steps or angled gangways. The ground floor of 12 Fulton is wheelchair accessible; Tours to upper floor galleries require steps. All participants on schooner *Pioneer* sails must have a ticket, regardless of age. Due to the outdoor nature of our ships, weather-appropriate clothing and sturdy footwear is recommended.




